- **Four outcomes**

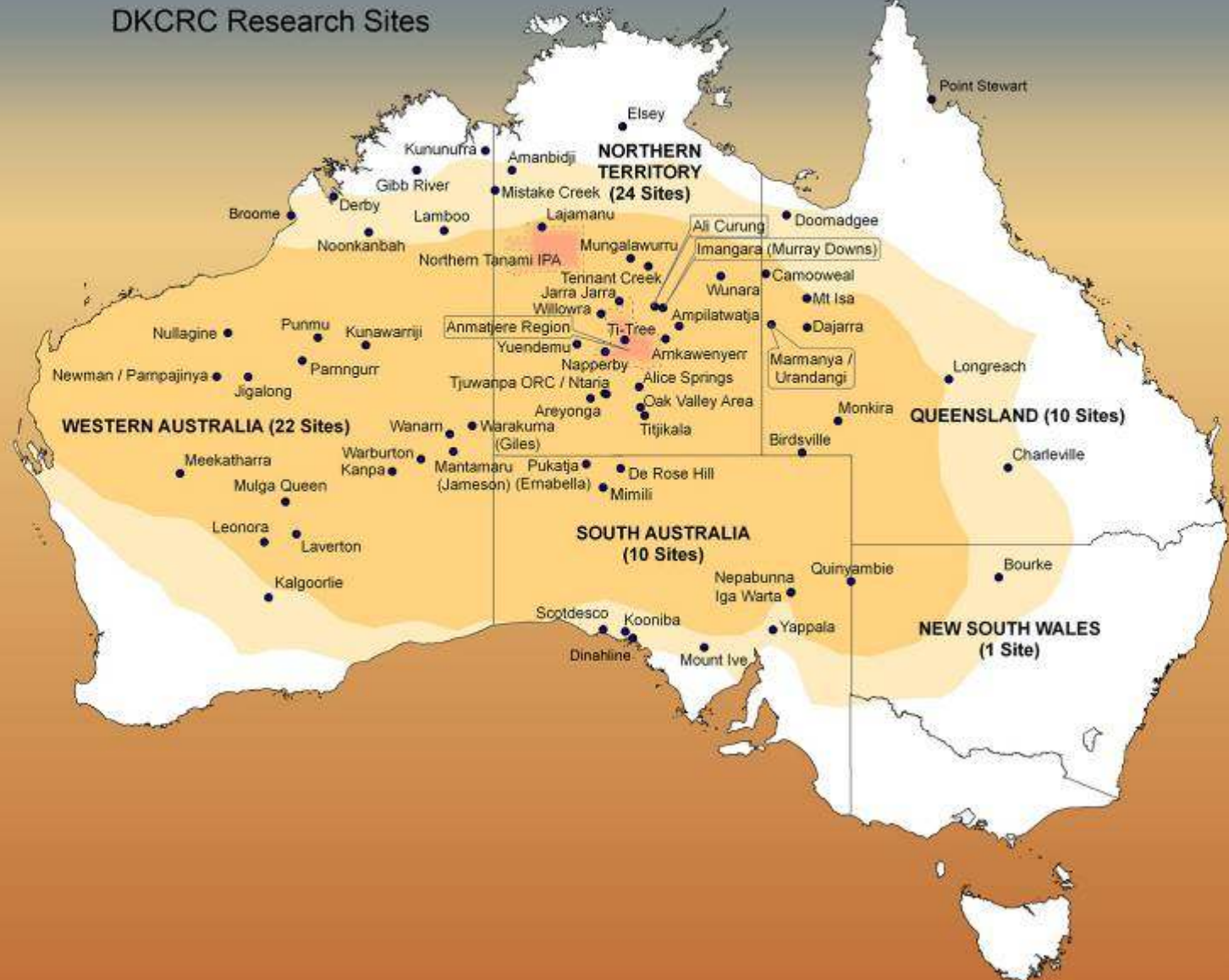
1. Sustainable livelihoods for desert people

 - Understanding IP in a cross cultural context




DKCRC Research Sites





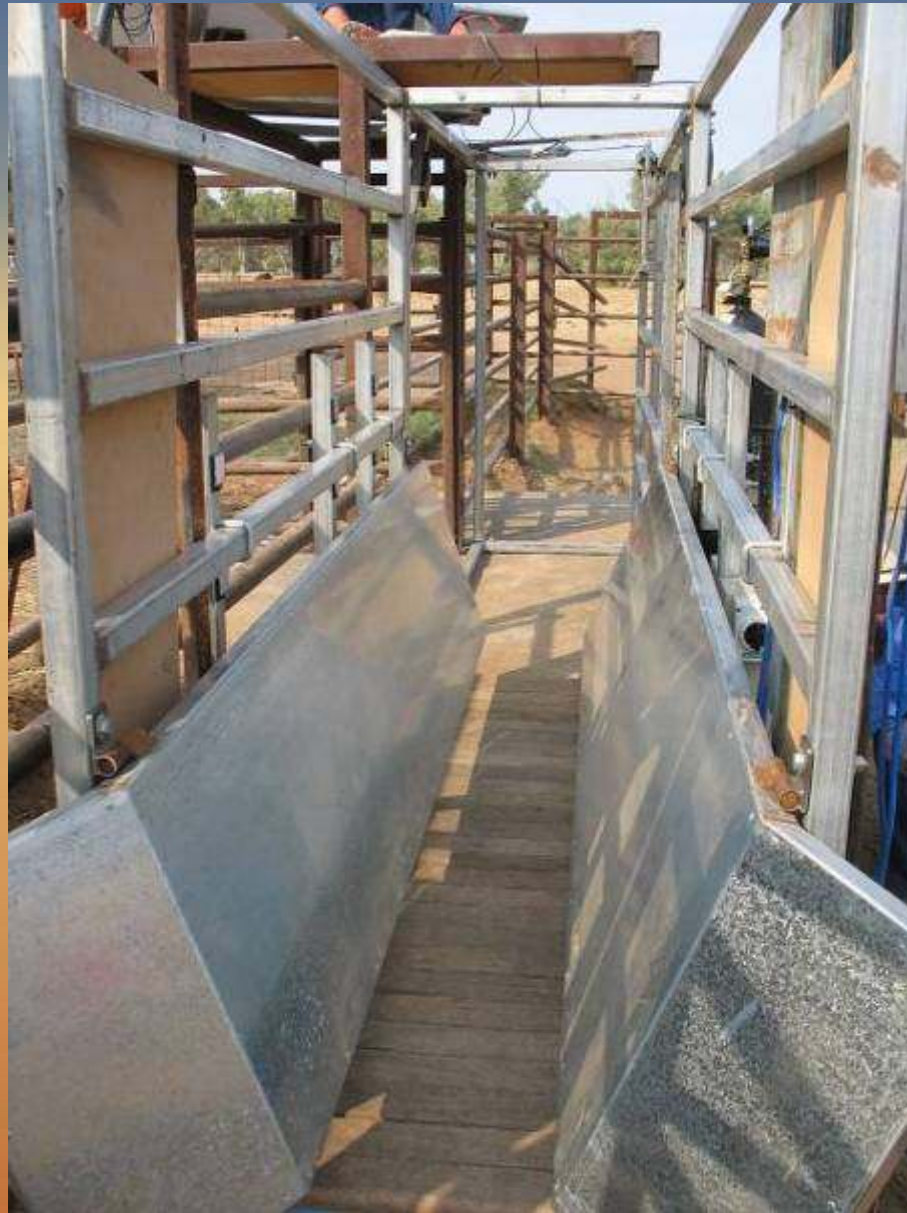
